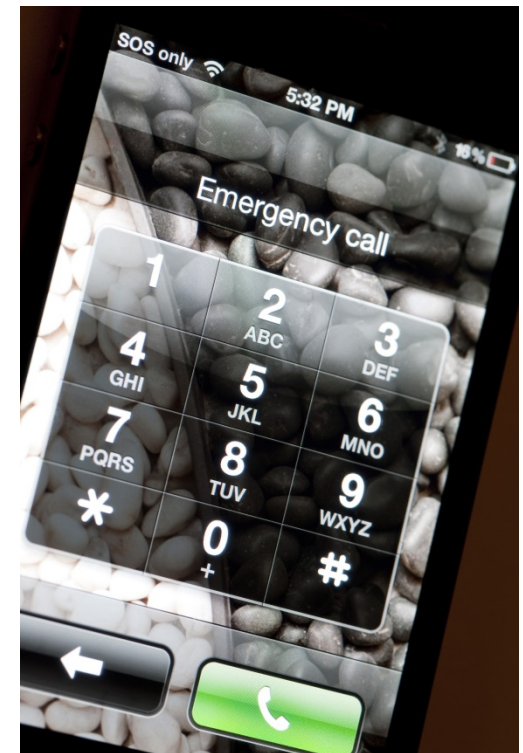
BHC Alert Line is your link to emergency managers at the Center! If you see an emergency taking place and **911 has already been notified**, you can instantly contact key staff members at:

325-216-8421

Please save the number in your phone.

Callers will be asked to record a voice message describing the situation. The voice message will be instantly transmitted to key leaders and all emergency managers at BHC.

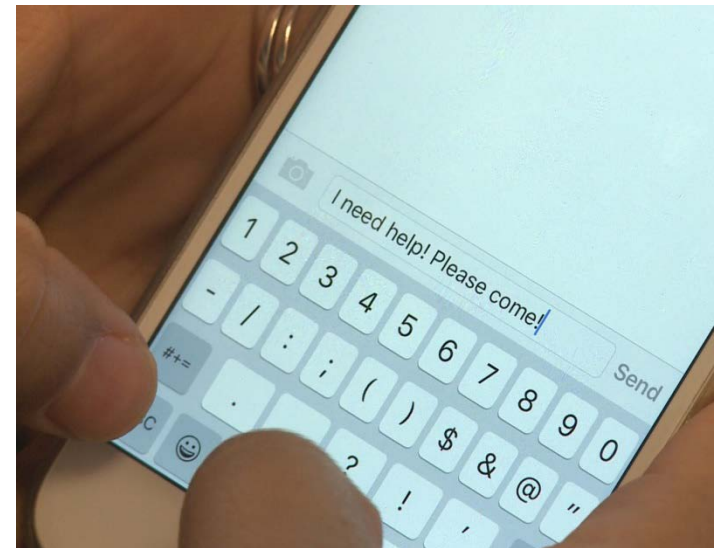
Ex: "A lion just crashed through the doors at RB Evans! We have called 911. One person is injured and the building has been evacuated."



You may also **Text** information to the Alert Line. Please provide the location and details of the situation.

Ex: "Code Blue at 2626. Called 911. Chemical spill in parking lot. Doors are secured. Avoid the area."

The text will be immediately sent to BHC emergency managers.



So, what happens next?

The message is instantly transmitted to emergency managers via text, email, and mobile app alerts. Staff will quickly review the information and send mass texts and emails to any employees who may be impacted.

Example Scenario: Alert Line receives a voice message about a lion at RB Evans. Notices are sent to emergency managers. They listen to the message and immediately issue a "Code Green" text and email to any staff on the north side. After the lion is captured and the site is secured, they will issue the "All Clear" text and email.

Example Scenario: Alert Line receives a text about a chemical spill at 2626 S. Clack. Notices are sent to emergency managers who review the information and immediately issue a “Code Blue” warning text and email to all staff on the south side. After the authorities deem the situation safe, the “All Clear” text and email will be sent.
